First, however, she recommended that I sample all of the committees that interested me, so that I could find the best fit. This was excellent advice!"

Kathie became an Ambassador when she joined the Membership Committee in 2009. She now spends about 1.5 hours each month in committee meetings and 1-3 hours each time she volunteers to serve as an Ambassador. Kathie says that she enjoys her role because it provides her with the opportunity to meet and get to know the Club's newest members, and to form relationships with fellow committee members.

Nancy notes that Anna's and Kathie's positive experiences are typical--and that the Ambassador Program keeps improving. This year, she and her subcommittee have developed official guidelines to ensure that everyone approaches the position in the same way and imparts the same information.

"Now," Nancy announces, "The opportunity to serve as a new member Ambassador is open to all members who want to participate—you don't have to be a 'full-time' Membership Committee member."
